- 1/4 yard Vintage Postcard Toss
- 1-1/2 yards Word Toss Teal
- 1/4 yard Word Toss, Gold
- 1/4 yard Word Toss, Natural
- 1/4 yard Vintage Postmark Toss

**READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING. SEW PIECES RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER AND USE A 1/4 SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC; LOF = LENGTH OF FABRIC**

## CUTTING:

### From Vintage Postcard Toss Fabric:

Cut [4] — 7-1/4" squares

Subcut on the diagonal into [8] triangles

### From Word Toss, Teal Fabric:

Cut [2] — 4-1/4" × LOF

Cut [4] — 1-1/2" × WOF

Cut [3] — 2" × WOF for Binding

Use remaining fabric for the backing

### From Word Toss, Gold Fabric:

Cut [2] — 1-1/2" × WOF

Cut [2] — 1-1/4" × 42-1/2" strips for Inner Border.  
This may need to be pieced

### From Word Toss, Natural Fabric:

Cut [2] — 1-1/2" × WOF

### From Vintage Postmark Toss Fabric:

Cut [2] — 1-1/2" × WOF

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

1. Copy the foundation paper piecing template [7] times.
2. Make the [7] Stacked and Stashed blocks by placing the 7-1/4" half square triangles in the large triangle space on the template.
3. Using foundation paper piecing technique to sew 1-1/2" strips to build the block following the placement lines of the template. Trim blocks on outer line to 6-1/2" square.

## ROW ASSEMBLY:

1. Join blocks, alternating direction as shown in the diagram below. Carefully remove paper.

## BORDER ASSEMBLY:

1. Sew Word Toss, Gold 1-1/4" × 42-1/2" inner border strips to each long side of the block row. You may need to piece the border strips to get to table runner length. Press seams toward border.
2. Sew Word Toss, Teal 4-1/2" × LOF border strips to each side of the project. Press seams toward outer border.

## FINISHING:

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind.
4. Enjoy!

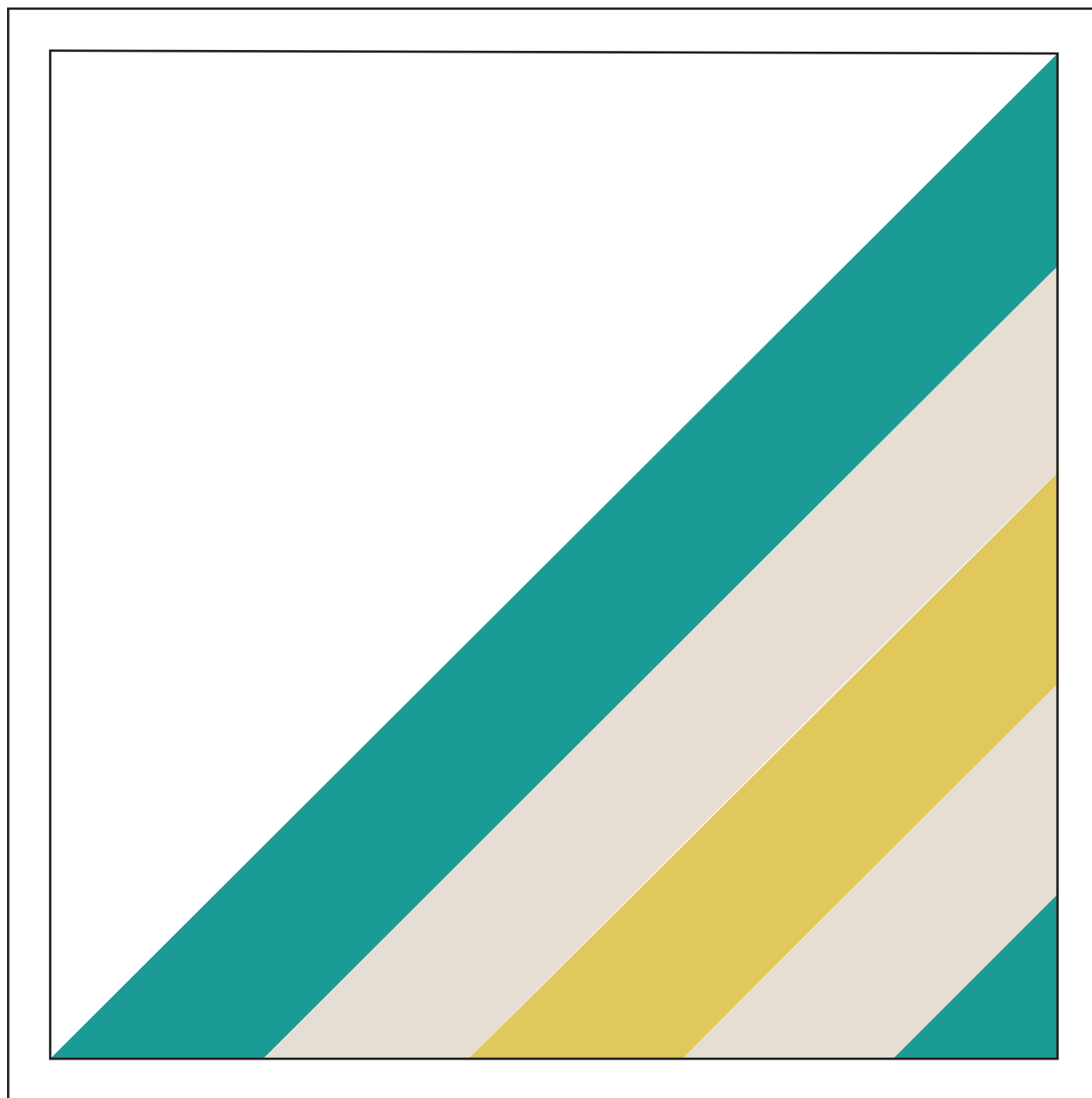
