



AMOSH Placemats

12" x 18"

Since each block can be used to create a variety of placemats, fabric requirements will be provided for both a single placemat and for making six placemats out of same fabric.

MATERIALS:

2 of each Placemat as shown below

[1] AMOSH Panel

1/3 yard Flowers and Bees

1/3 yard Missouri Words Blue

1/2 yard Missouri Birds Blue

1/4 yard Hexagonal Tonal Golden Yellow

7/8 yard, Binding

1-1/2 yards, Backing

6 Identical Placemats

[1] AMOSH Panel

1/2 yard for side sections

3/4 yard, Border

7/8 yard, Binding

1-1/2 yards, Backing

BEFORE SEWING, READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS.
ALL SEAMS ARE 1/4" UNLESS OTHERWISE
STATED. CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS ARE BASED
ON 40" WOF. WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC;
RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

CUTTING:

From AMOSH Panel:

Cut [6] — 9" × 9-1/2" motif rectangles

From Side Section Fabric:

Cut [1] — 5" × WOF strip, for each pair of placemats

Subcut [12] — 5" × 9-1/2" rectangles (for the 3 variations, cut half from [1] fabric and half from the other; cutting a total of [4] strips for the variations)

From Border Fabric:

Cut [2] — 1-3/4" × WOF strips for each placemat

Subcut [2] — 1-3/4" × 18" strips for each placemat top and bottom

Subcut [2] — 1-3/4" × 12" strips for each placemat sides

From Binding Fabric:

Cut [12] - 2-1/2" × WOF strips, Binding

ASSEMBLY:

1. Stitch [1] side section rectangle to the right and left sides of the Panel motifs.
2. Sew the 1-3/4" × 18" strips to the top and bottom of the unit from Step 2.
3. Sew the 1-3/4" × 12" strips to the sides.

FINISHING:

1. Prepare your quilt sandwich by layering backing fabric, batting, and placemat top. Pin or baste securely. Quilt using your preferred method.
2. Binding - Sew strips together end to end to form [1] continuous strip. Attach binding using your favorite binding technique.
