

Make a total of [4] units for each side of the pillow.

FPP (Foundation Paper Piecing:

- Cut out the template just outside the dashed lines.
- Place the wrong side of the fabric for section 1 (A1, B1, etc.) against the back side of the template (side NOT printed). Hold up to a light source, make sure the fabric covers the entire section, overlapping the adjacent sections by $\frac{1}{4}$ " on all sides. Secure the fabric with a dab of glue.
- Find the line that runs between section 2 (A2, B2, C2, etc.) and section 1.
- Fold the foundation back along the line between the two sections AND Trim the exposed fabric to $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
- Fold the paper back down. Flip the foundation paper over. Place the second fabric for section 2 on top of section 1, right sides together and lined up with the edge just trimmed.
- Hold in place and flip the foundation over, printed side up.
- Stitch on the line between the two sections (A1 & A2, B1 & B2, etc.) Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " before & after the line (or to/from the edge of the paper). The stitching will be in the seam allowances.

REPEAT these steps (Trim, Stitch, Press) until you have completed the foundations

- Fold the paper back.
- Trim the excess fabric to $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
- Line up the next piece on the trimmed edge.
- Flip the foundation over sew on the printed line.
- Press (press, do not iron)
- The last steps to prepare the FPP are: trim any excess, trimming on the outer dashed lines.
- REMOVE THE PAPER once blocks have been sewn together.
